# HOW DOES YEAR 1 DIFFER FROM THE FOUNDATION STAGE

- First year of the New National Curriculum
- Learning is more structured
- Developing independence and confidence through the curriculum

#### READING

- Reading is more than just decoding text.
- Children need to develop good reading skills to understand what they have read.
- To help the children develop these skills, they will sometimes be asked to read the same book twice.
- Please listen to your child reading daily and record this in their yellow reading record.
- We will check and change reading books daily.
- Please ask your child questions about the text they have read and get them to ask questions as well.
- It is also really important to read to your child, as this helps to expand their understanding and vocabulary.

#### **PHONICS**

- Year 1 will be doing phonics daily, so please ask your child what sound/sounds we are covering this week.
- We are working towards the phonics screening check in June.
- In 3 weeks time you will receive 8 spellings for your child to learn that week which are related to the phonics we are covering. These will come home on a Friday and it is up to you how you learn them. The spelling test will be on the following Friday.
- The book will need to be back on a Friday ready for us to put their new spellings in and to write their score of that days spelling test.

#### Writing

- Writing in Year 1 will develop their independence, confidence and give them the opportunity to use their phonic knowledge.
- We will be working inline with the curriculum to improve their creative writing as well as their grammatical knowledge. Handwriting will be taught weekly as well.
- Every other week there will be a piece of English homework sent home to continue to work on these skills. Please can you allow them to spend around 20 minutes on this homework.
- Homework will be given out on a Friday to be returned by the following Friday please.

#### MATHS

- What is covered in maths:
- Number: addition, subtraction, place value and multiplication
- Fractions (½ and ¼)
- Money
- Shape (2D and 3D)
- Position and movement
- Measures (length, weight, capacity and time)

#### SUPPORTING IN MATHS

- Maths homework will be alternated with the English homework. Again please spend 20 minutes on the homework. It is given out on a Friday to be returned the following Friday.
- Additionally to the set homework, all of the following will help your child's math develop:
- \* Talk about the size of objects (bigger, taller, shorter)
- \* Get them involved with cooking (heavier, lighter)
- \* Look at the calendar, talk about days, months
- \* Ask them the time (o'clock and half past)
- \* Get them to use money in real life situations
- Mathletics. Your child's log in will be stuck in the front of their yellow reading records.
