# **PTA NEWS**



# Woodpecker Class' Stone Age to Iron Age Adventure!

Year 3 enjoyed a drama-filled morning, cementing their understanding of the Stone Age and developed knowledge of the Bronze and Iron Ages during the Theatre Exchange workshop.

The children met 'Stone Age man', explored how people's lives changed from the Paleolithic to Neolithic eras and investigated a longhouse, deciding what families would have used each room for.

Moving into the Bronze Age, children re-created a summer Solstice scene at Stone Henge, before thinking about how Iron changed people's lives. We are really looking forward to getting started with Arbor's Parent Portal & Arbor App and invite all our parents to familiarise themselves using the link below.



# POLIO / VACCINATION REMINDER

You may have seen in the news that polio has been found in London sewage water – although this represents a small risk to the public, it's a timely reminder to ensure children are fully up to date with their vaccinations. Polio vaccine is part of the routine national immunisation schedule.

If you or your child are not up to date with your polio vaccinations, it's important you contact your GP to catch up or if unsure check your Red Book.
