As our school charity for 2024-2025, the School Council thought it was very important that we could all hear about how our fundraising could support this very important charity. Rachel from Air Ambulance, told us that the helicopter could reach anywhere within Kent, Surrey and Sussex within 30 minutes. The organisation needs about £56,000 a day to run, but we learnt that just £20 could pay for one set of tubing for the ventilator.
