Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to a new and exciting start at Tatsfield Primary School. We are thrilled to be your child's class teachers this year and are both so excited to get to know you and your family, and to support your child in their learning journey. We are dedicated to fostering a safe, supportive, and fun learning environment where your child can thrive. We can't wait to embark on this exciting year of learning and growth with your child.

### **Teaching Staff**

The staff working in Early Years this year are:

- Mrs Persson – Teaching Assistant Monday – Friday
- Mrs Jewitt (Head Teacher) and Mrs Stevens (Teaching Assistant) will be in Wren Class during teacher planning time

### **Equipment**

Here are a few reminders of what the children will need to bring to school each day:

- Water bottle
- Additional piece of fruit if required (one piece of fruit per child is provided by the school every day)
- Book bag
- Reading record and book
- Packed lunch, unless they are having school lunch (school lunch is free for all pupils in Reception Class – more information is on our [school website](#))
- Coat/weather appropriate accessories

Earrings should not be worn to school.

Please can all items be clearly named.

### **PE**

PE days will be on **Tuesdays and Fridays**. Children should come to school wearing their PE kit on these days (starting Friday 12<sup>th</sup> September. ## **Reading**

Children have been given a picture book this week, along with their reading record for you to record comments about their story sharing with you. To make reading a positive experience for your child, establish a daily routine and create a comfortable, distraction-free reading space. Engage your child by letting them choose books, talking about the pictures, using funny voices, and encouraging them to participate in the story. Reading aloud builds their language skills, vocabulary, and empathy, but also strengthens your bond by providing quality time together. Their story starts with you. It only needs 10 minutes of your time each day.

## **Homework**

Throughout the year, other activities for your child will be given for them to share with you. Once we start learning our sounds in Phonics, sound cards and key word cards will come home alongside a phonics activity sheet for your child to complete. These activities will support and consolidate their learning in class and inform you of their learning.

## **Tapestry**

We will also be setting up Tapestry accounts for you so that you can see your child's progress and development during their year in Reception. Tapestry is a secure online Learning Journal to record photos, observations and comments, in line with the Early Years Foundation Stage curriculum, to build up a record of your child's experiences during their time with us. More information will be sent to you soon.

## **Amazon Wishlist**

Each year, every year group sets up a class Amazon wishlist. Everything on the list will be used to aid the children's learning and classroom environment. More information with links etc will be sent out in due course. Thank you in advance for any contribution you can make.
