**Movement in March – 1k for £1k**

We have been invited by [Re:Water](#) (see flyer on page 2) to take part in a running challenge throughout March – 1k for £1k. This will be a great opportunity to be active, as well as raise funds for our school! Our PE Leader, Mrs Collins, has organised 'Movement in March' to help our pupils, families and members of staff be involved in this exciting challenge.

The attached flyer contains more information about the event, but in summary:

- Pupils, families and staff will work together to run a total of 1000km in a month
- Children should bring a pair of trainers into school every day during March (please label them with your child's name)
- If we beat the challenge, Re:Water will donate £1000 to the school!
- Tatsfield Primary School will be one of the first schools in the UK to take on the 1k for £1k challenge!

Our running track on the school field is 275m. Children will be given the opportunity to run or walk laps of the track every lunchtime and at times throughout the week with their class.

On Mondays throughout March, the school field will be open until 4pm so that families (and staff!) can run as many laps as they can after school. Re:Water ask that participants take part in the challenge at their own risk and encourages participants to take on the challenge carefully and responsibly. If children are running on their own, an adult will need to present on the field until they have finished their laps.

Year 6 Junior Leaders and members of staff will record distances run by children in each class and during lunchtime. Families will be able to record distances they run on Mondays after school using this [Microsoft Forms link](#).

We hope this active idea will get everyone moving during March, work as a team to reach the 1000km target and help us to raise much needed funds for our school!
